

Nucor Director's Pavilion



The Nucor Director's Pavilion, located on the far east side of the Missouri State Fairgrounds near the Centennial Gate along Highway 65, is a 20,000-square-foot open-air venue built in 2020. Constructed with state legislative support and in partnership with Nucor Steel of Sedalia, which provided the steel structure, it offers a spacious, versatile setting for community use. The pavilion is home to the Sedalia Area Farmers' Market from April to October, except during the Missouri State Fair.
