The Sheep Pavilion, built in 1965 and renovated in 2020, offers an open-air facility with a concrete floor. Located on the southwest side of the Missouri State Fairgrounds, it features approximately 430 pens and one show ring, making it ideal for sheep exhibitions. A convenient benefit of this pavilion is its ample parking and easy trailer access for unloading livestock.

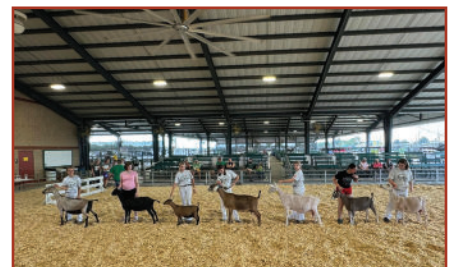
